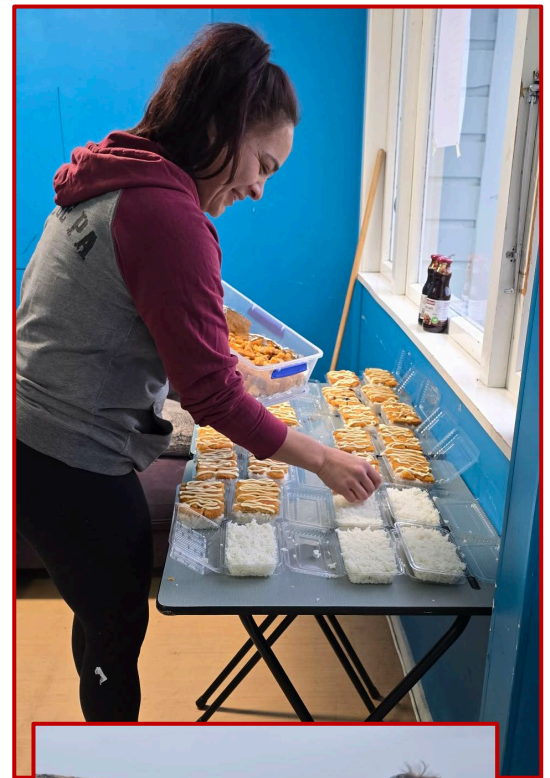

Pulse Well-being Survey

Once again, as part of our Positive Behaviour for Learning (PB4L) approach, we are using a product called Pulse to measure the well-being of our students in Years 5 to 13. It assesses the well-being of individual students so that the school can respond to those who express a need for help from supporting staff.

Pulse will collect anonymised data on the emotional, physical, and social drivers of well-being so that we can make changes based on students' voices.

Our students will be expected to complete their Pulse check-ins once a week, in class time. The school leadership will review the data on a termly basis, and we will share some of the aggregated data with the students to get their feedback about what is going well and what can be improved around the school. The first weekly check in will be in **Term 2, week 2**.

The data we collect via Pulse will be an essential part of ensuring that we can respond to our students' needs in a relevant and timely



manner. However, if you want to remove your child from the process, please contact the school office on 03 4468460.

We look forward to working as a community to measure and promote well-being at our school.
